New Changes to the 2009 Tournament

Enjoy the Tournament at the NEW Century Club Village

The Century Club and Buick Invitational are proud to announce the creation of a new spectator area on the South Course called the Century Club Village. This area will be approximately 20,000 sq. ft., almost doubling the size of the previous Party Deck. It will be located between the 15th green, 17th green, and 18th tee on the South Course of Torrey Pines and will be open everyday of the tournament until 5:00 p.m.

The Century Club Village will include a beer garden, two large Mega LED screens featuring live television and tournament highlights, and a more extensive concession area.

Enhancing the Village will be the relocation of two major venues: the official Merchandise tent and the Century Club Pavilion tent. The merchandise tent will be moved from its previous location behind the 18th hole. This will bring together a unique shopping and dining experience with an added convenience for all fans!

The Century Club Pavilion tent, which is a special hospitality area for those with a Patron Badge, will be moved from the 7th tee. An added element to the Pavilion tent is the expansion of the outdoor deck, providing additional spectator seating on the 15th green, making the Pavilion tent the place to be for an optimum viewing spot.

Bringing together these different attractions in one central location makes the Century Club Village a definite must see for an enhanced fan experience!

Kid Zone sponsored by Jack in the Box

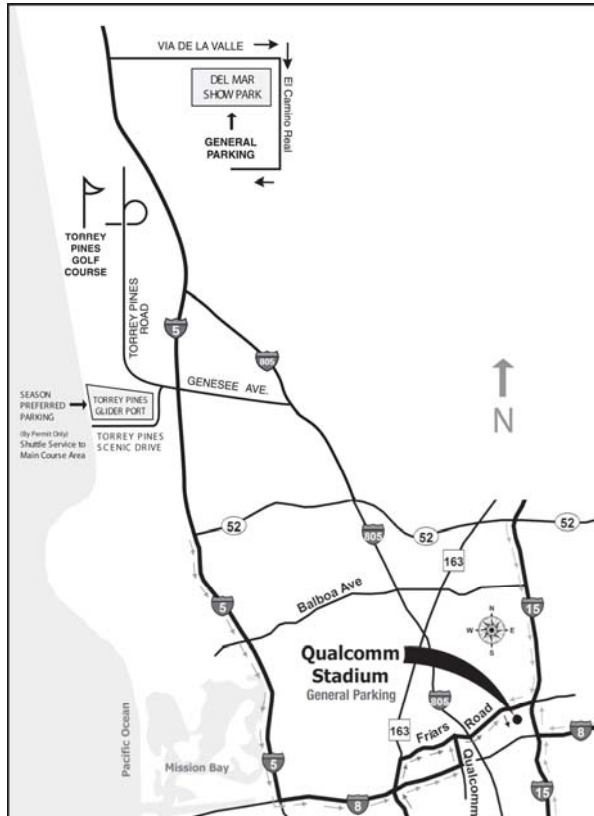

It will be a place for children to take a break from watching golf and have some fun by testing their own skills with the game.

Military Appreciation Pavilion will be moving!

The Century Club started a new tradition in 2008 with the creation of an on-course Military Appreciation Pavilion during tournament week. This year the Military Appreciation Pavilion has been moved and will now be located on the 14th green. The Military Appreciation Pavilion will be open to all active-duty military personnel and their immediate families. It will feature the MCCC Miramar snackbar, which offers complimentary sandwiches, soft drinks, water and snack food items.

New General Parking Information

The Buick Invitational, set for February 2-8 at Torrey Pines Golf Course, has announced their General Parking lot locations for the 2009 tournament. General parking will be available only at the Del Mar Show Park and Qualcomm Stadium. Patrons will be shuttled continuously throughout the day from these two locations to the golf course. Parking is \$15 per vehicle (this includes the roundtrip shuttle service).



SPECTATOR DIRECTIONS TO DEL MAR SHOW PARK

The Del Mar Show Park is located off Interstate 5, exit Via de la Valle, go East and proceed right on El Camino Real.

SPECTATOR DIRECTIONS TO QUALCOMM STADIUM

North from Interstate 5

Take Interstate 5 South to Exit 20 (Interstate 8 East). Take Interstate 8 East for approximately 3.5 miles and Exit Right following signs to Qualcomm Way. Take Qualcomm Way for approximately .5 miles and turn Right onto Friars Road East. Follow Friars Road East for approximately 1.5 miles and turn Right into Qualcomm Stadium.

North from Interstate 15

Take Interstate 15 South to Exit 7 (Friars Road). Turn Right on Friars Road West for approximately .5 miles. Turn Left into Qualcomm Stadium.

South from Interstate 5

Take Interstate 5 North to Exit 20 (Interstate 8 East). Take Interstate 8 East for approximately 3.5 miles and Exit Right following signs to Qualcomm Way. Take Qualcomm Way for approximately .5 miles and turn Right onto

Friars Road East. Follow Friars Road East for approximately 1.5 miles and turn Right into Qualcomm Stadium.

South from Interstate 805

Take Interstate 805 North to Interstate 15 North. Take Interstate 15 North to Friars Road West Exit. Turn Right on Friars Road West and proceed for approximately 1 mile. Turn Left into Qualcomm Stadium.

South from Downtown Freeway 163

Take Freeway 163 North to Friars Road East Exit. Follow Friars Road East for approximately 2.25 miles. Turn Right into Qualcomm Stadium.

East from Interstate 8

Take Interstate 8 West to Interstate 15 North. Take Interstate 15 North to Friars Road West Exit. Follow Friars Road West for approximately 1 mile. Turn Left into Qualcomm Stadium.

West from Interstate 8

Take Interstate 8 East to the Qualcomm Way Exit. Exit Right following signs to Qualcomm Way. Take Qualcomm Way for approximately .5 miles and turn Right onto Friars Road East. Follow Friars Road East for approximately 1 mile. Turn Right into Qualcomm Stadium.

All patrons who do not have the proper parking credentials at the Genesee Avenue exit off Interstate 5 will be diverted to the General Parking locations indicated on this page.
