#### Registration will be done using this online form to collect your information

- Your assigned tee time will <u>only</u> be delivered by email from one of these accounts.









## TICKETS AND PARKING

#### Each participant will receive an email on Monday Jan 20 containing:

- Ticket One (1) digital grounds ticket per participant (and instructions to download)
- Parking One (1) digital parking pass for the Torrey Pines Gliderport lot located at
   2800 Torrey Pines Scenic Dr, La Jolla, CA (see map below)











## RECEIVING YOUR TEE TIME

- Tee Times are assigned in advance of your Honorary Observer Experience
- You will not be able to select the group of players you will follow
- You will receive an email at least one (1) day prior to your Experience with details
  - Final rounds (Rd 3 & Rd 4) tee times are not set until the night prior to those rounds
- Please ensure that you have provided a valid email address in your registration










## DAY OF EVENT INFORMATION

- Please arrive and park at least 1 hour prior to your tee time
  - Parking will be at Gliderport. Check-in will be at the East Gate Entrance
  - NOTE: It is 1 mile from the Main Entrance at the Gliderport to the East Gate and Check-in Location (estimated walk time in crowds = 30 minutes)










## DAY OF EVENT INFORMATION

- Check-in with the Honorary Observer representative at the East Gate Lodge Room following the route as noted on the map below
  - If your starting tee is #10 South, please check in here 45 minutes prior to tee time
  - If your starting tee is #1 South, please check in here 30 minutes prior to tee time









## DAY OF EVENT INFORMATION

- At check in, you will receive your Inside-the-Ropes Credential
  - You will also receive an ULTRA zone wristband, a clear backpack, a custom Melin hat, snacks, water, coffee, and any final instructions for the day
  - You will also receive a food voucher for breakfast or lunch (not redeemable in the ULTRA Zone)
  - The ULTRA Zone is a shared hospitality area located at the No.9 Tee area and includes unlimited beer, soda & water, dedicated concessions (for purchase), covered seating and upgraded restrooms










# ATTIRE

- Standard golf attire is required
  - Long pants or golf shorts for men
  - Long pants, golf shorts, or skirts for women
  - Comfortable walking shoes or golf shoes
    - Waterproof shoes recommended
- Attire <u>NOT</u> permitted:
  - Jeans, cargo pants or cargo shorts
  - T-shirts or any shirt without a collar
  - Metal spiked golf shoes or open-toed shoes
- Hats and sunglasses are encouraged
- Umbrellas may be used for shade or rain









#### RULES OF THE COURSE

#### DO NOT WALK IN THE FAIRWAY!

- If caught, TOUR Security will revoke your Insidethe-Ropes privileges
- Always walk within arm's length of the rope
- Follow rope line according to back of credential
- Stay hydrated drinks are available on tee boxes
  - Help yourself after the players have left the tee
- Food and bathroom breaks are permitted
  - Leave the rope line near a marshal and re-enter the rope line near a marshal showing your badge
- Drinking alcohol, smoking, or using any tobacco products is prohibited

#### **Honorary Observer**

Please walk in close proximity (five feet or less) of the ropes at all times.

Walking Scorers and Standard Bearer Volunteers have duties that require
them to walk in different areas than Honorary Observers.

Please use the below guide to help you navigate which side of the fairway to walk on.

#### Torrey Pines - SOUTH COURSE

| Hole 1 | RIGHT | Hole 10 | LEFT  |
|--------|-------|---------|-------|
| Hole 2 | LEFT  | Hole 11 | LEFT  |
| Hole 3 | RIGHT | Hole 12 | LEFT  |
| Hole 4 | RIGHT | Hole 13 | RIGHT |
| Hole 5 | LEFT  | Hole 14 | RIGHT |
| Hole 6 | LEFT  | Hole 15 | LEFT  |
| Hole 7 | LEFT  | Hole 16 | RIGHT |
| Hole 8 | RIGHT | Hole 17 | RIGHT |
| Hole 9 | LEFT  | Hole 18 | RIGHT |







# RULES OF THE COURSE

- Use of cell phones is not permitted inside the ropes
  - Please <u>Silent</u> all cell phones (or turn off)
  - Voice calls must be made outside the ropes and away from any players in the field
  - Range finders and cameras are not permitted onsite during competition rounds
- PGA Tour Players may or may not introduce themselves
  - Do not interact with the players or caddies
  - Do not consult on any official rulings on course
  - Do not ask for photos or autographs until the round has been completed (but be aware of players mood)









## RULES OF THE COURSE

- Walking Scorers and Standard Bearers have duties that allow them in the fairway
  - Do not follow them in the fairway; rather stay level with them along the rope line.
  - Meet up with them around the green as you watch the players putt. Follow them to the next tee box.
- You are assigned to one (1) group ONLY
  - You may <u>not</u> jump to another group that might have premier players you wish to follow
- In the event of inclement weather and stoppage of play, please take cover
  - When play resumes, you may rejoin your group
